On Wednesday, September 7 from 6:30-8pm is a training time for any adult interested in volunteering, whether you've done it for years, or are new. If you're interested in being on a team but aren't sure what it entails, contact the staff about the details of that area. This training time will prepare you for what you'll be doing this school year.

1) Ministry Team – This team is a weekly commitment. If you are unable to attend, you are responsible for coordinating with staff to fill your spot. All curriculum provided - help lead discussions as small group leaders or co-leaders OR lead students in games and activities. Choose according to how you're best able to serve.

JUNIOR HIGH

Sunday Mornings – WIRED 9:30-10:30am – WIRED is our large group experience, includes a time of music, teaching, and breakout groups that could be different each week.

Sunday Nights – AMPED 6-7:30pm – AMPED is our small group experience, includes a time of games, small groups that will be the same each week based on grade and gender, a time of teaching, and reflective worship through music.

Sunday Mornings - CONFIRMATION 9:30-10:30 – This is a year-long ministry leading 7th grade students on a weekly basis in small group environment wrapping up that morning's topic.

Retreats, activities, mission trips – dates TBD. We have fall, winter, and spring retreats each year. About once a month, we'll have a fun activity or service opportunity for students. In the summer we offer a mission trip experience.

SENIOR HIGH

Sunday Mornings - wake up @ the Lodge 9:30-10:30am – Team of 3 needed to lead small group discussion and games for teens who want to stay at the lodge.

Sunday Mornings - wake up @ The Big House 9:30-10:30am – Team of 3 needed to help lead small group of "Mission Minded" students who want to go deeper.

Sunday Nights - LIVE! @ the Lodge 6-7:30pm – Team of 10 volunteers needed to help in one of many areas for our large group time of welcome, games, worship, discussion, etc.

Weeknights - Bible Study Co-Leaders, time TBD. Volunteer to lead a student generated Bible study during the week. Sites could be in a home, restaurant, etc.

Retreats, activities, mission trips - dates TBD. We have fall and winter retreats each year. About once a month, we'll have a fun activity or service opportunity for students. In the summer we offer a mission trip experience.

The Fundraising and Support Teams involve seasonal volunteers. It is not a weekly commitment. Between the Fundraising and Support teams, please choose at least two.

2) Fundraising Team — There are a variety of fundraisers each year where students can participate and earn scholarship credits for retreats, mission trips, and other activities. This team provides volunteers to organize and run each fundraiser. Choose according to how you're best able to serve.

PUMPKIN SALES: There are multiple shifts available throughout October including week nights after school. Each weekday shift is 4-7pm. On Saturday/Sunday, there are 3 shifts available each day. Please sign-up with your son or daughter.

Shift Volunteer - This person needs to be available for the shift to sell pumpkins

Weekly organizer – assists in recruiting shift volunteers for one 7-day period. 3 volunteers needed, 1 for each week. Contacts each volunteer via email or phone to confirm commitment for next day. Be willing to fill in a shift volunteer slot if needed. Time commitment about 2-3 hours for the week.

Shift Organizer - One adult volunteer needed for each shift to oversee 2-3 youth volunteers to sell pumpkins. Duties include handling, counting and turning in the money. Accounting for time earned by the youth volunteers. Shifts are 3-4 hours long. If you choose to volunteer, someone will follow up with you to confirm specific dates and shift times that work for you.

Unloading Day – 4:30-7:30. As many volunteers as we can get to unload and setup pumpkin sales area from delivery truck. Specific day TBD.

Clean-up Day – noon-2pm. 10-15 volunteers needed to clean up pumpkin area. Move all remaining pumpkins and items. Specific day TBD.

PIZZA SALES

Pizza Sales Leader – Manage the entire pizza sales process. Recruit parent and youth volunteers; Over-see the pizza-making day, distribution day and on-going pizza sales through the month of January.

Pizza Making Day – February 4 from 9am-1pm. 10 volunteers needed to assist and oversee youth in building the pizzas.

Pizza Distribution Day – February 5 from 8am-12:30pm. 3-6 volunteers split between 2 shifts needed to help distribute pizza on Sunday during church.

Pizza Sales – January 8, 15, 22, and 29 from 8am-12:30pm. 2-4 volunteers for each Sunday needed to assist youth volunteers on Sunday mornings taking pizza sales orders during church hours.

THANK-YOU BREAKFAST and SILENT AUCTION – Specific date TBD.

Food Coordinator for Silent Auction - Recruits 10 volunteers to provide and set up all food/drinks, and manages serving and food preparation during auction

Auction Coordinator - Oversee set up of tables and items, signage for items, bid sheets, and help finance coordinator

Finance Coordinator - Manages money, take payments, and follow up with winners

3) Support Team - This team provides support as needed to the youth ministry and staff. Choose according to how you're best able to serve.

Jr. High Food Coordinator - Recruits meals and sends reminders for monthly meals

Greeting team - Greet teens and parents and answer questions at the beginning of Sunday Youth Group one Sunday per month

Office Support - Assist with computer, mailings, etc. 2-3 hours per week/month
