

COVID-19 UPDATE – 7/30/2021

Due to the recent CDC and local government recommendation, we are highly encouraging our congregation to wear a mask to church this Sunday. As we have shared with you throughout the last year and a half, we continue to follow the direction of the Marion County Health leaders who are recommending that everyone in the Indianapolis area once again mask up indoors in light of federal recommendations for both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.

What to expect this coming Sunday, August 1st:

- Bring and wear your own mask
- There will be clean masks available at entrances and volunteers will offer them as you enter.
- All St. Luke's Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks.
- Those speaking from the chancel or stage will remove their mask while presenting. We will vacate the first 2 rows in the Sanctuary & Robertson.

The safety of our congregation, children and guests is our highest priority. We will continue to ask all children, volunteers, and parents in the Children's wing to wear a mask. Because children are not vaccinated and join us in worship, it is important that we observe the safety measures in the worship space as well. Our volunteers will continue to serve donuts and coffee in Fellowship Hall in a safe manner.

We know this is a step backwards, and yet we believe we can still have fellowship and a meaningful worship experience. As always, our primary goal is to do no harm, and we believe this approach helps us achieve that goal.
