*Before looking at the story with your child and talking about it, watch this for yourself: [How to Talk to Kids about Race](#)*

**Watch the read aloud [Black is a Rainbow Color](#) by Angela Joy.**

**Afterward, if your child is 5 and older:** Talk about the different colors of skin that your child sees. Make sure to discuss the beauty, the difference, anything similar, and how wonderful these differences are. Talk about the different hair and eye color. Make sure to emphasize how wonderful these differences are that we see and how we can celebrate all of it! Then grab a box of crayons and color something that you felt inspired by from the story.
